1.) Class introduction

4.) Chinese Courses Introduction

The Chinese Confucius Classroom offers Chinese language courses to meet different needs at different levels. Teachers will arrange teaching activities, choose appropriate textbooks, and set corresponding teaching goals to achieve the best teaching goals.

For the beginner courses, as the students all start at zero, therefore the teachers will use the HSK Standard Course textbooks, which is a set of textbooks written for people who want to pass the Chinese proficiency test. Practical topics are combined with communication, so that students can learn Chinese in a more practical manner. The teachers will also combine video, music and other means to expand the students' understanding of China. In addition, a cultural salon class is organized every month, where students can experience the charms of Chinese culture, such as paper-cutting, calligraphy, making Chinese knots, Chinese chess or playing shuttlecock. At the end of the one-stage learning process, teachers will organize students to register for the HSK exam. Students who pass the exam can get a certificate awarded by Hanban of China and can continue to study or work in China in the future.
