AMENDMENT No. 1

to Organizational Directive No 1/2011

Final and habilitation theses at the Technical University in Zvolen, which was approved by the management of TU Zvolen on 5 September 2011

Article 1

Organizational Directive No. 1/2011 Final and habilitation theses at the Technical University in Zvolen is amended by the resolution of the Management of the Technical University in Zvolen dated 21.1.2013 as follows:

1. Article 5 (1) reads:

(1) footnote - STN ISO690:1998. Documentation - Bibliographic references - Content, form, and structure, STN ISO 690-2: 2001 - Information and documentation. Bibliographic citations. Part 2: Electronic documents or parts thereof - **is replaced by STN ISO 690** valid from May 2012.

2. Article 6 (1) (c) and (d) read:

- (1) The formal quality of the thesis is based on the standards:
 - (c) STN ISO 690: 2012 Information and documentation Information and documentation. Guidance for the creation of bibliographic references to information sources and their citation.
 - (d) is deleted.
 - (e) is changed to (d).

3. Article **7** (1) reads:

(1) Final theses are submitted in printed form in one copy at the relevant department (bachelor and diploma theses), or in printed form in four copies at the relevant supervising department (dissertations).

4. Article 7 (4) reads:

(4) The author (student, author of the habilitation thesis) is obliged to submit the final thesis or habilitation thesis also in electronic form, in .pdf format, by uploading it to the UIS, including all annexes. The author of the habilitation thesis cooperates with the Department for Science and Research of the Technical University of Zvolen in fulfilling the obligations arising from Article 7. The electronic form of the thesis or habilitation thesis must be identical to the printed form of the thesis or habilitation thesis. The author is responsible for the conformity of the printed and electronic form. The size of the electronic file must be less than 50 MB.

5. In Article 7 (8) reads:

(8) The UIS will allow the printing of the "License agreement for the use of the final/habilitation thesis", the author's request for extension of the grace period for making the thesis or habilitation thesis available" and the "Affidavit of publication of the final and habilitation thesis under non-periodical or periodical publication" only after the electronic form of the thesis has been uploaded to the UIS and the correctness of the uploaded data has been confirmed by clicking on the button "Submit the thesis".

6. Article **7** (**10**) reads:

(10) The licence agreement shall be signed in two copies, one of which shall be given to the author and the Technical University of Zvolen.

7. Article **7** (11) reads:

(11) The Dean/Rector, after the prior statement of the thesis supervisor, shall express his/her opinion on the extension of the deferral period. The Dean may agree or propose a different grace period. If the author's disagreement, the process of the author's submission of the Application and approval by the Dean/Rector shall be repeated only after a mutually accepted grace period has been reached.

8. Article 7 (15) reads:

(15) After the successful defence of the thesis, the SLDK will carry out its bibliographic registration. The bibliographic data are made available through the library's information system.

Article 2

This Amendment No. 1 to the Organizational Directive No. 1/2011 Final and habilitation theses at the Technical University in Zvolen enters into force from the date of approval by the Management of the Technical University in Zvolen on 21 January 2013.

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Rector
